GESE - Topic Phase

Introduction

Candidates begin the exam by talking to the examiner about a topic that they have chosen and prepared. The purpose of the topic discussion is to create a natural exchange of information, ideas and opinions between the candidate and the examiner.

The topic form

The candidate must bring a completed topic form into the exam room.

This can be completed by a person other than the candidate, as written skills are not assessed in these exams. The form can be created by the candidate or downloaded from the Trinity website. (You choose a topic to prepare in advance of the test, for discussion with the examiner. You must complete a Topic Form in advance and bring it with you to the exam.)

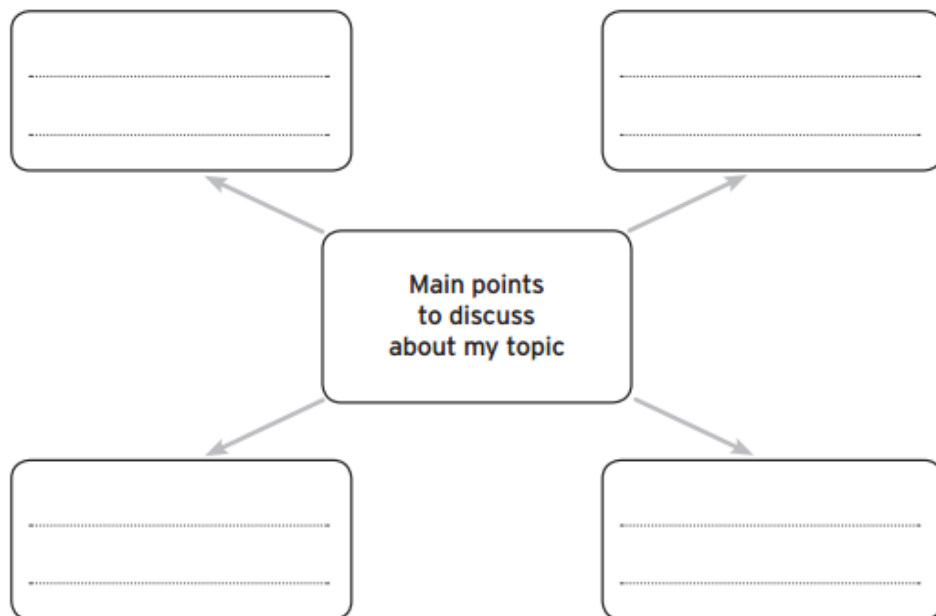
