The Possessive Form

When somebody owns something we say he possesses it. The form of the noun is known as the **Possessive Form**.

Changing a sentence into possessive form.

Ex:- My sister has long hair.

Sister's hair is long



The possessive form of sister is sister's

How the possessive form of the pronouns are formed. ?

Ex:- The father's car is red.

His car is red.

The pig's tail is curly.

Its tail is curly.

Note:- When we write the possessive form of 'it', it does not have an apostrophe
