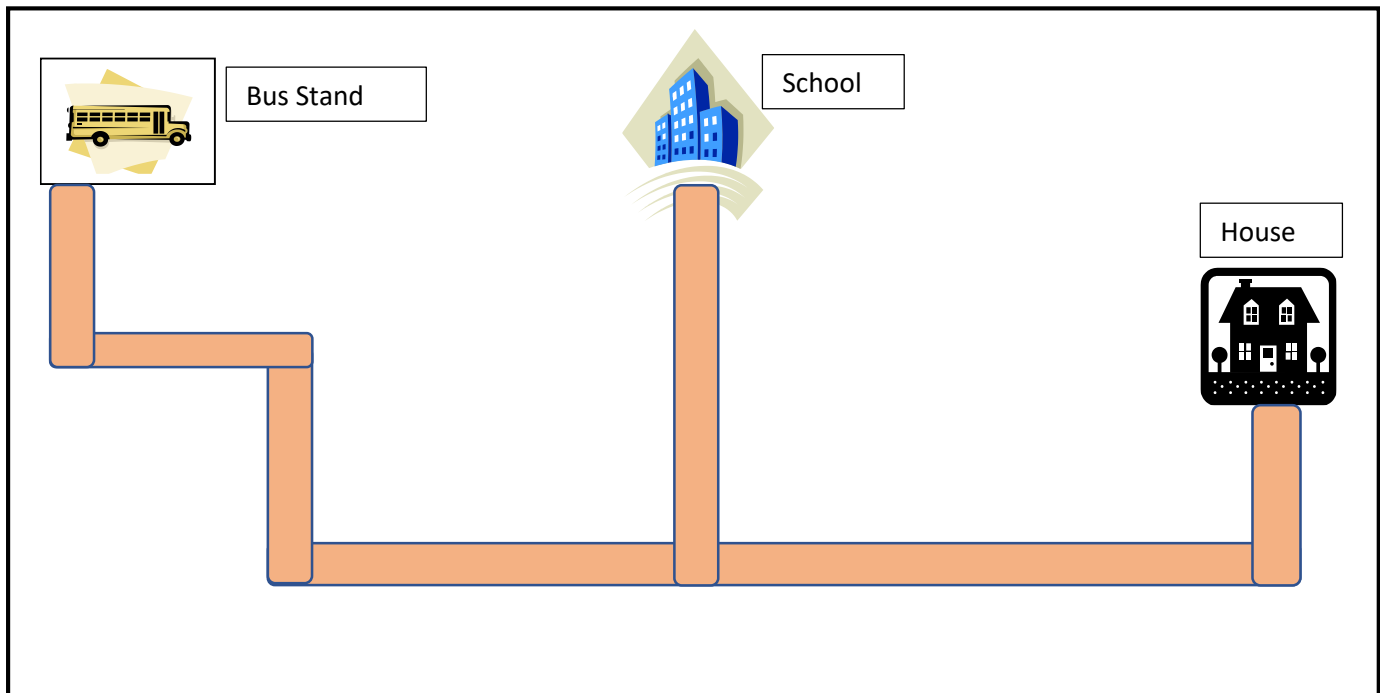
Students will draw a rough sketch about main roads and other important places around the school in a A4 sheet and paste it.

Example : direction from school to the bus stand

- Start from school.
- Walk along the street and then turn to the right.
- Again walk along the street and turn to the right.
- Again walk along the street and turn to the left.
- Again walk along the street and turn to the right.
- Again walk along the street then you will see the bus stand.

How to cross the road.

Look right, look left, and look right again.

Cross the road on the yellow lines then.

Now you are safe on the road and lane.

So you know how to cross the road again.

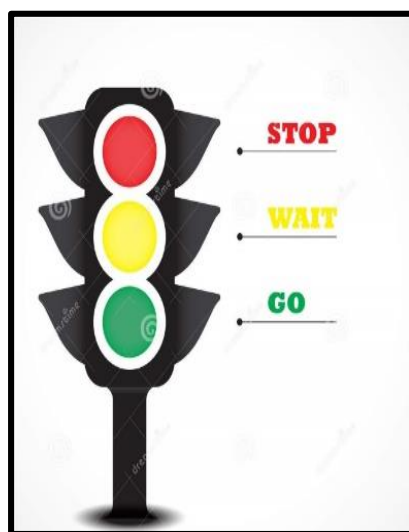
How can we prevent accidents that can happen on the road?

- Always use yellow crossing/ white crossing when crossing the road.
- Hold the adult's hand and look at the right side and left side then again right side to ensure there is no vehicle on the road before crossing the road.
- Always use the right side when walking on the road.
- Do not walk on the railway.
- Always be cautious to check the railway signals before crossing the railway.

Signal lights that we can see on the road and vehicles

- Main lamps / street lamps
- Signal lights (to stop , get ready to go and, start going)
- Reverse light (it is inbuilt in vehicles)
- Vehicle signal lights (it is inbuilt in vehicles to show the vehicle's directions when turning it)
- Siren (the ambulance and police jeeps to use in an emergency)
