<u> Unit 10 – My Home Garden</u>

Let the children to draw a home garden and label basic things that could be found in a home garden. (Fence, flower garden/ vegetables garden, plants and trees etc.)

- We all have a home garden. It is the area around our house. We must keep our home garden clean and tidy.
- ✤ It gives you real delight and makes you happy.

<u>Things in our home garden are very useful and important to our lives. Here</u> <u>are some of them.</u>

- Plants and trees Provide shade and medicine
 - Can get fresh fruits and vegetables
 - Can get vegetables free from chemicals
- **Flower plants** Beautify the environment
 - Provide flowers for religious activities
- Gate Provide security
- **Fence** Prevent entering of animals and unknown visitors
- ➤ Well Can get water.
- **Swing** Can enjoy it.

Basic things to follow when preparing the home garden for the cultivation

- Cut down the unnecessary trees in the home garden to get enough sunlight.
- The soil on land should be a mixture of sand and clay and it should be basined.
- Make soil fertile by adding organic fertilizer. (<u>Ex</u>: leaves, cow dung, etc.)
- Free of soil erosion by building retaining walls or keeping slopes, grow grass.
- Remove excess rocks and stones.
- Arrange regular water supply to the garden

Seeds that plant quickly in the home garden

- Tomatoes
- Beans
- Chilly
- Brinjals
- Green gram
- Long beans
- Ladies fingers

Activity: Green bean planting project

Things we need:


- Green gram seeds
- Cotton wool
- Jam bottle
- Water
- Soil



Method:

- Fill the Jam bottle with cotton wool and place some beans in it randomly.
- Spray water on the cotton till they wet
- Place it in a place where it gets sunlight and observes it every day. It is advisable to use a magnifying glass to observe the seed in the first few days.

How do we plant crops in our home garden?

- Select a suitable place
- Removing weeds, stones, and rocks from soil.
- Tilling the soil by adding compost
- Making beds of a plant at a regular distance
- Planting seeds at a regular distance
- Watering Plants

Use waste products to make a recyclable home garden

- A piece of gutter
- Discarded curd pots
- Coconut huts
- Tins
- Wooden boxes
- Wire mesh
