- ❖ She was an Albanian, born in Macedonia.
- ❖ Lived in Calcutta (Kolkata) in India.
- ❖ She was born on 26<sup>th</sup> August 1910.
- ❖ Died on September 5<sup>th,</sup> 1997. (Age 87)
- ❖ She formed an Order called Missionaries of Charity.
- ❖ She helped the poor, weak and the needy in streets of Calcutta.
- ❖ She won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1979.
- ❖ In Sri Lank,a there are two places of Missionaries of Charity in Mutwal and Moratuwa.
- ❖ Mother Theresa was beatified by John Paul II on 19 October 2003 as Blessed Mother Therese.
- Canonized Blessed Mother Theresa as a saint done by Pope Francis in Rome on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2016.
- ❖ Feast of Saint Mother Therese is on the 5<sup>th</sup> of September.
- ❖ She was the patron saint of world youth day, missionaries of Charity and Archdiocese of Calcutta(co patron).
- ❖ Another name we call is her "the saint of the gutters".
