Lesson 10 - Speaking about future using “going to”

- We use “going to” when we want to talk about future actions and future plans.

Affirmative Sentences with “going to” - Structure

Subject + am/is/are + going to + verb

Examples: I am going to sing a song.
He is going to read the newspaper.
They are going to play football.

Negative Sentences with “going to” - Structure

Subject + am/is/are + not going to + verb

Examples: I am not going to eat meat this week.
She is not going to play with her friends.
We are not going to climb the mountain.

Question form with “going to” - Structure

Am/Is/Are + Subject + going to + verb ?

Examples: Am I going to read this book now?
Is she going to dance at the party?
Are they going to play the match in the evening?
