- Adjectives are words that describe nouns.
- Adjectives can be placed before and after the nouns. And also, after the 'be' verb.

Examples: That is a big car.

The heat made the child sleepy.

This castle is huge.

- Adjectives are used to describe,

 2. Size
 3. Shape
 4. Age

 6. Origin
 7. Temperature
 8. Material

Comparative and Superlative adjectives

- Comparative adjectives are used to show the difference between two nouns.

Examples: My father is taller than me.

Her ball is bigger than her sister's.

- Superlative adjectives are used to show the difference between more than two nouns.

Examples: Today is the happiest day in my life.

Mahaveli is the longest river in Sri Lanka.
