01 - Services rendered by the temple to the community

• All religious functions conducted at home are done with the guidance of the temple of the village. Eg: The Dana, Bana, and Pirith

02 - The services rendered by the resident monks

The monks who reside at a temple render a variety of services to the temple and community,

- Early morning monks take turns and sweep the compound and cleaning the shrine rooms.
- Attend to the needs of the leading monk.
- A senior monk of a temple is assigned the task of maintaining a diary of events

<u>03 -Responsibilities of a monk</u> Keepeping record of the heeldana offered to the temple.

- The pirith ceremonies for which monks have to be supplied.
- Supplying monks to functions of other temples.

04 -Other responsibilities of a monk residing in a temple

• Provide facilities for any monk who may request accommodation to spend a night attending a function in the area.

05 - Close relationship with the temple

- Dayakayas have to participate in the functions and celebrations that are in the temple of the village
- Visit the temple for religious rituals on every poya day and offer flowers to the Dagaba, the Bodhi and the Buddha statue.
